Airports Council International and Ecole Nationale de l'Aviation Civile to offer Advanced Master's Degree in Airport Management

Montreal, 7 March 2016 – Airports Council International (ACI) and Ecole Nationale de l'Aviation Civile (ENAC) have today signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for cooperation on the launch of an advanced aviation training programme, the Advanced Master's Degree in Airport Management, aimed at developing the next generation of airport professionals. The signing, which took place today at the Millennium Gloucester Hotel during ACI's 8th Annual Airport Economics and Finance Conference, marks the first time that ACI will partner with a university to offer an airport management degree.

As part of the agreement, ACI will use its extensive network of airport members to provide expert instructors for the course, which will cover key areas of the airport business such as airport revenue generation; financial and managerial accounting for airports; airport team and human resource management; business aviation; airport crisis management; airport security and facilitation; airport

terminal and landside operations; and airport master planning. In turn, ENAC, founded in 1949 in Paris-Orly, and internationally recognized as a leader in the field of aviation management education, will take advantage of its considerable academic and organizational experience to deliver this unique Master's level course.

"ACI, through the hard work of its Global Training department, is committed to educating the next generation of airport professionals through in-class and online courses that cover all aspects of airport management and operation," noted Angela Gittens, Director General, ACI World. "Our partnership with Ecole Nationale de l'Aviation Civile represents a next step in ensuring that we continue to offer quality educational options for airport professionals. Moreover, ENAC's status as a premier venue for aviation training, coupled with the advanced nature of the degree, sends the clear message that a career in the airport industry is a challenging pursuit that can bring lifelong rewards."

"This educational partnership will help to develop the next generation of senior airport professionals," said Marc Houalla, President, ENAC. "We welcome the opportunity to join forces with ACI and are excited at the prospect of helping to ensure the long-term sustainability of the airport industry through this joint initiative."
